Malory's "Morte Darthur" is a late-medieval translation of both English and French Arthurian texts, but his translations of the knights and ladies who appear in his French sources entail cultural and theological as well as linguistic transformations. By studying Malory's translations of the Quest of the Holy Grail and the love affair of Lancelot and Guenevere, students will discover how Malory secularizes a sacred quest and glorifies an adulterous couple.
