Equipe enseignante:

You can do an internship at a business, a government agency, or a non-governmental organization. The teacher of the internship is the person responsible at these organizations that oversees your day-to-day activities. Contact Professor Maarten Voordouw at the University of Neuchatel for any questions concerning the internship.

Objectifs:

The objectives of an internship are varied. You can use an internship to obtain work experience in an organization and to acquire new skills.

Contenu:

Internships or stages typically occur during the summer after exams have finished (in the months of July and August). The intern will be expected to work for at least 20 full workdays (four weeks) in the chosen organization. This corresponds to 20 days*8 hours/day = 160 hours of work. The student typically takes an additional two weeks to write the report.

Forme de l'évaluation:

At the end of the internship the student has to write a report that will be evaluated by the supervisor of the internship.

Pré-requis:

There are no pre-requisite courses.

Forme de l'enseignement:

Learning will be on-the-job training in a real life work environment.
