Objectifs:

The course aims to introduce students in the law and practice of the European Union as an international actor.

Contenu:

The course is divided in two parts. In the first part, we discuss the foundations of the law of external relations of the EU, and in the second, specific policies (e.g., common commercial policy, human rights, etc.). The course visits the European Court of Justice in Luxembourg on April 4-5, 2016. This is a required aspect of the course.

The students who take both this course and the « Module européen – Théorie et pratique de l'UE » have the possibility to participate in the « Semaine européenne » on April 4-7, 2016 (see description above in the course catalogue). During this European week, visits will take place at the EU Court of Justice in Luxembourg (4-5 April) and at the EU institutions in Brussels (6-7 April).

Forme de l'évaluation:

The mode of examination is described in detail in the relevant Law Faculty statutes. Students are required to take two multiple-choice exams, one in the mid-semester, and one at the end of the semester.
