Objectifs:

Practical Language classes are designed to help students consolidate and improve their proficiency in understanding and using spoken and written English. The course also aims to broaden students' knowledge of the cultures of English-speaking countries.

Contenu:

Language work is approached through analysis and discussion of authentic texts and audiovisual materials on a variety of general interest topics, as well as on different aspects of the cultures of English-speaking countries.

Forme de l'évaluation:

Continuous assessment: two 2-hour written tests (50% each) near the end of each semester (dates and times to be announced). Rattrapage by one 2-hour written test (100%) at the time of the following FLSH exam session (only possible if the two regular in-course tests have already been attempted).

Documentation:

Course materials will be distributed in class and posted on the practical language moodle site.

Recommended :

- any modern advanced learner's dictionary (e.g. Macmillan, Oxford, Cambridge, Longman, Cobuild)

Pré-requis:

Before beginning this course, students need to have reached a level in English of at least B2 (Common European Framework), roughly the equivalent of the Cambridge First Certificate Examination.

Forme de l'enseignement:

Analysis of authentic texts and audiovisual material; discussion of language points and aspects of English-speaking culture that arise from the material.
