Objectifs:

To provide students with exercises and practical applications of what has been discussed in the Introduction to English Linguistics lectures.

Contenu:

This course offers an introduction to the scientific study of language. We will discuss what general facts about language have been discovered, how language differs from animal communication systems, how different linguistic structures can be analyzed and how linguistic forms convey meaning.

Forme de l'évaluation:

The workshop will be graded based on the following:

Participation (10%)

- This entails maintaining regular attendance and participation in the course activities.

Quizzes(90%)

- There will be two quizzes per semester for this one year course.

Rattrapages

- In order to earn a passing grade, students need to achieve at least an average of 4 at the end of the year. A failing grade incurs a rattrapage of a written exam that will cover material spanning from the entire year.
