Contenu

Internships are best scheduled for July and August, after the exam season. Internships require a minimum workload of 20 full days or 160 hours in the chosen organisation, followed by a period of two weeks of report writing.

The final report will have to be read and evaluated by the internal supervisor of the internship, who will report his/her feedback to the course controller (Klaus Zuberbühler). Evaluation is in the form of continuous assessment on a pass/fail basis.
