The Sports Arbitration Moot (the "SAM") is an annual team competition for students in law schools. Moot competitions are fundamental tools for the legal education of future practitioners, who get to develop their advocacy skills while completing their studies. The SAM aims at contributing to the creation of a broader and more knowledgeable sports arbitration community. The SAM consists of a competition where teams will make oral submissions as Appellant and Respondent. The 2023 edition of the SAM will be held online, with the Final Rounds (i.e. at least the best eight teams) taking place in person.
