This seminar addresses a frequently encountered enigma in social and human sciences: how can we explain behaviors or beliefs that are vastly different from our own? We will collaboratively delve into this question by reading pertinent texts from prominent authors in anthropology, sociology, history, and psychology.

Forme de l'évaluation

Every participant should select a phenomenon that appears difficult to comprehend initially. In a roughly 10-page essay, they should offer a personal reflection and attempt to elucidate how individuals might have behaved or believed in the manner they did.

Documentation

Texts discussed in class will be available on the class Moodle. These references will then be expanded individually based on the various topics addressed by the students in their essays.

Pré-requis

A solid background in social or human sciences is certainly advantageous, but this seminar is open to anyone who is motivated.
