Objectifs:

The seminar is designed to help students to achieve the two following objectives: 1) critically read and analyze theoretical and empirical texts in the field; 2) familiarize with some recent anthropological and cultural psychological literature on family and related topics.

Contenu:

This course introduces students to the concept of 'family' through an examination of some core notions (e.g., gender, home, marriage, migration, education), and through the analysis of different ethnographic examples. The course will adopt an anthropological and cultural psychological perspective on the study of family, and will focus on various understandings of 'family', as well as on the main social and cultural processes shaping family relations, parenthood and marriage patterns.

Forme de l'évaluation:

Students are expected to read all the assigned texts, to give an oral presentation - individual or in group depending on the participants' number - on one of the selected texts, and to formulate questions in order to engage others in a discussion. The others will be required to read the text presented so as to actively participate during the session. Guidelines on how prepare the presentation of the text will be provided during the course.

At the end of the course, students are also expected to produce a short essay (5-6 pages) in English on the skills and knowledge achieved during the seminar. Deadlines for submission: 9th June 2015, 1st July 2015, 31st July 2015.

Documentation:

The texts will be made available on Claroline before the start of the course.

Pré-requis:

This course is open to all Bachelor students.

Forme de l'enseignement:
