Objectifs:

To provide students with exercises and practical applications of what has been discussed in the Introduction to English Linguistics lectures.

Contenu:

This course offers an introduction to the scientific study of language. We will discuss what general facts about language have been discovered, how language differs from animal communication systems, how different linguistic structures can be analyzed and how linguistic forms convey meaning.

Forme de l'évaluation:

The workshop will be graded based on the following:

Participation (10%)

- This entails maintaining regular attendance and participation in the course activities.

Homework Assignments (90%)

- Small written assignments will be made available for each sub-section of the course which must be passed in on the date indicated.

Rattrapages

- In order to earn a passing grade, students need to achieve at least an average of 4 in all the homework assignments. A failing grade incurs a rattrapage of a larger written assignment on a linguistic topic assigned by the instructor.

Documentation:

Readings and exercises will be distributed on the class's online platform.

Pré-requis:

The class requires no prior knowledge of linguistics. English language skills are necessary.

Forme de l'enseignement:

This is an activity-based course which will include only minimal formal lecturing.
