### Objectifs:

The aim of this course is to familiarize with those current debates that, in the field of anthropology and sociocultural psychology, have focused on the conceptual relationship between emotions and the subjective experience of human mobility.

### Contenu:

This course focuses on the relationship between emotions and human mobility through the reading of some theoretical and empirical texts in anthropology and sociocultural psychology. Special attention will be given to: the role of emotions in the relationship with sociocultural diversity; migrants' subjective experiences; socio-cultural construction of emotions in migration processes; transnational belonging and families; the role of objects in migration.

## Forme de l'évaluation:

Internal evaluation is based on: the writing of an essay (approx. 10 pages; in English or in French); reading texts and active participation during the course (including individual/group exercises and class discussions).
