**Objectifs:**

This seminar will be linked to a research conducted within the Cognitive Science Centre on the phenomenon of interest. More precisely, we try to elucidate the following question: in daily conversations, what do people talk about and, more generally, what interests them.

**Contenu:**

In a first step, students will have to survey the literature and present an article that they found particularly relevant to the topic. In a second step, students will do some fieldwork in different contexts in order to collect data on conversation. These data will then be analyzed and presented in class.

**Forme de l'évaluation:**

The evaluation consists of an essay (about 10 pages) that will present and analyze the data while proposing some hypothesis about interest in conversations.
