The objective of the course is to introduce students to the social and cognitive processes of human conversational interaction. A particular focus is on the interdisciplinary nexus of research of conversation and its methodological implications

Contenu:

Foundations, communication, coordination and conversation, turn-taking, audience design, entrainment, synchrony, multimodality, facework and affiliation, joint actions, joint multitasking, conventionalization, and organizational coordination

Forme de l'évaluation:
