## Contenu

Practical Language aims to improve students' command of grammar and usage as well as their ability to interpret spoken and written discourse and to engage with a variety of culturally relevant topics. The course combines theoretical discussion of different areas of language with practical work on authentic texts and digital materials drawn from across various English-speaking cultures and beyond. Students can enhance their language awareness through grammar practice, analysis of different types of texts and other resources (literary extracts, newspaper articles, podcasts, etc.) and discussion of the broader issues which they raise. The course is designed to be immediately relevant to students' practice and to offer useful insights to those who wish to become language teachers.

### Forme de l'évaluation

Continuous assessment: a two-hour written exam near the end of the semester (dates and times to be announced). Students will be allowed to use a monolingual dictionary but will not have access to any course materials. In the case of remote teaching, the exam will be administered via Webex.

# Modalités de rattrapage

In case of failure, the rattrapage will be a two-hour written exam at the end of the second semester. Students will be allowed to use a monolingual dictionary but will not have access to any course materials.

### Documentation

Course materials are distributed in class and posted on the Practical Language Moodle site for download.

### Pré-requis

Before beginning this course, students need to have reached a level in English of at least B2 (Common European Framework), the equivalent of the Cambridge First Certificate Examination.

#### Forme de l'enseignement

Workshop: grammar practice and discussion of language points and questions of usage; analysis of authentic texts and digital materials; discussion of various culturally relevant topics.
