#### Contenu

In this course we will study Milton's Paradise Lost, one of the greatest and most famous works of literature in English. We will analyse the poem in detail, reading one book per week.

#### Forme de l'évaluation

An in-class test of 1h20 during the final week of the semester in which you will be invited to analyse sections of the poem to produce an analytical essay (50%). You will be given corrected, graded copies of your in-class test to develop into a final draft of your essay which is to be submitted as a Word document by June 30th 2024 (50%). The aim is to offer you an opportunity to write under timed conditions and to then take time to develop your essay writing skills by redrafting the same piece of work.

In the event of a sanitary crisis, teaching will take place online (via WebEx, as will the in-class presentations and in-class test.
