This lecture course will give students an overview of the history of the English language, literature and culture from the beginnings (c. 500) to the decline of the medieval period (c. 1580). Time will be reserved for workshops where students learn how to read, translate and interpret excerpts from both Old and Middle English texts. Students are encouraged to read the texts on the reading list prior to the discussion in the classroom.
