Continuous assessment (Pass/Fail)

To earn the credits, students must:

- Prepare the introduction for at least one invited speaker.
- Create a PPT slide summarising the key message of the talk they introduced, to be shared on the Centre for Cognitive Sciences' social media.

Failure to meet any of these requirements will result in a fail.

Modalités de rattrapage

Students who do not satisfy the attendance requirement need to submit a dossier. The dossier should include a summary (max. 500 words) and two discussion points of a research paper for each invited speaker seminar that the student has not attended (up to 80% of the sessions). The research papers should be (co-)authored by the invited speakers. The selection of the research papers to summarize will need to be approved beforehand by Prof. Diana Mazzarella.
