This seminar will be dedicated to an exploration of narratives. How to describe them? What roles do they have, individually and socially? How can we describe a good narratives? Why do we feel the need to tell stories?...

Forme de l'évaluation

Each participant will first present orally a published paper that sheds important light on the understanding of narratives. Then, in an essay of about 10 pages, each person will describe a story that has been important in his or her life and propose an attempt to explain why this might have been the case.

Documentation

Texts discussed in class will be available on the class Moodle. These references will then be expanded individually based on the various topics addressed by the students in their essays.

Pré-requis

A solid background in social or human sciences is certainly advantageous, but this seminar is open to anyone who is motivated.
