Contenu

Not a day goes by without the press reporting on a doping scandal. Doping has become a societal problem. Historically the almost exclusive domain of sports federations, doping is now the subject of numerous international conventions and state laws. The aim of this course is to systematically address the various legal aspects of the fight against doping. The first step will be to recognize the central role of the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA), both in defining the list of prohibited substances and in developing applicable sports regulations. Among the other actors involved in the fight against doping, particular attention will be paid to the role of doctors, particularly with regard to the issuance of therapeutic use exemptions, which is very important in practice. At the level of sports federations, the course will cover the main stages of a doping procedure, from anti-doping control to possible disciplinary sanctions, including sample analysis, without forgetting the many issues raised by the biological passport. With regard to national law, the focus will be on the strengthening of criminal provisions against doping, as provided for in the Federal Act on the Promotion of Sport and Exercise. However, it should not be forgotten that the occurrence of a doping case can have many consequences, both in terms of general private law (termination of employment and sponsorship contracts) and criminal law (fraud against organizers).
